



## GRADE SEVEN LATE FRENCH IMMERSION PROGRAM INFORMATION MEETINGS for 2026-2027

Dear Parents/Guardians and Grade 6 student,

If you are considering Late French Immersion for the upcoming school year, you are encouraged to attend an information session in order to learn about the program. On Prince Edward Island, this is a program offered at the intermediate level, beginning in grade seven.

French immersion:

- Offers students whose first language is not French the possibility of completing the prescribed PEI curriculum in French;
- Helps students develop strong communication skills in both English and French;
- Enables students to interact spontaneously and confidently in French;
- Creates lifelong opportunities and fosters an appreciation of other languages and cultures.

In February, intermediate schools that offer the Late French Immersion program will hold their annual Late French Immersion Information Meeting. Parents/Guardians and students are encouraged to attend these sessions in order to be able to make an informed decision about this six-year commitment. Please contact the school directly if you have any questions regarding these information sessions.

The Late French Immersion program is currently offered in the schools listed in the table below. The dates for these information sessions are also listed in the table. If you are unable to attend the information session at your designated intermediate school, please feel free to attend one of the other sessions.

Parents/Guardians and students that are interested in Late French Immersion are asked to complete the registration form and return it to your child's grade six teacher by **Tuesday, March 10, 2026\***. The registration form will be available after each information session. It will also be available at each elementary school and on each intermediate school webpage.
